The 2019 N.R.A. Open Sectional-National Indoor Pistol Championships are being fired at Sectional Tournaments throughout the United States. They are operated by match staff composed of local match officials. Each individual competitor and team firing in a Sectional will automatically be entered in the National Championship at no additional charge.

The Roslyn Rifle and Revolver Club will conduct this N.R.A. Sectional Match at their Indoor Range located at 1130 Broadway, Westbury, New York 11590.

RULES: Current NRA Pistol Rules will govern.

EQUIPMENT: Any safe .22 Caliber Pistol or Revolver (NRA Rule 3.4). Triggers may be weighed and will be weighed if National Records are broken.

TARGETS: NRA B-2, slow fire target, NRA B-3 timed & rapid fire target. Distance: 50 Feet

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. Unclassified shooters will fire in the Master class. Classification cards and Temporary Score books will be checked. Assigned classifications may be used (NRA Rule 19.6).

SCORE CARDS: Sectional score cards will be used and **MUST BE SIGNED BY THE COMPETITOR** to be considered for national ranking and awards.

SCORING will be done by match personal.

CHALLENGES: A Challenge fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each challenge, to be refunded if upheld. (See Rule 16.1).

EYE and EAR PROTECTION are **MANDATORY**.

TEAM ENTRIES: Team Captain or first team member to fire the match must complete team entry card. Team fees must be paid prior to firing match. Team members (4) are not required to be squaded as a unit to fire.

ENTRIES LIMIT: Entries are limited to 100 competitors. Post entries will be accepted if space is available.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squaded and firing points will be assigned by the Statistical Office.

MATCH SCHEDULE:

MATCH 1: 20 shots, slow fire, 2 strings of 10 rounds each, each string fired in 10 minutes

MATCH 2: 30 shots NRA Gallery Course 10 shots slow fire, 10 shots timed fire, 10 shots rapid fire

MATCH 3: 20 shots, timed fire, 4 strings of 5 rounds, each string fired in 20 seconds

MATCH 4: 20 shots, rapid fire, 4 strings of 5 rounds, each string fired in 10 seconds

MATCH 5: Sectional Individual Championship (Aggregate of matches 1 thru 4)

MATCH 6: Sectional Team Championship, 30 shot gallery course fired by all 4 team members

MATCH 7: National Individual Championship, scores from match 5 used

MATCH 8: National Team Championship, scores from match 6 used

AWARDS: If there are fewer than 5 entries in a category, they will be combined with another category within the same class. All competitors in the class will be moved to their respective category in the next higher class. Competitors of lower classification will not be combined with the High Master Class. If fewer than 5 entries in the High Master Class, they will compete for open awards only. An individual or team winning an Open Award will not be entitled to a Class Award in the same match; such awards will be passed down.
