The 2019 N.R.A. Open International Sectional-National Indoor Pistol Championships are being fired at Sectional Tournaments throughout the United States. They are operated by match staff composed of local match officials. Each individual competitor and team firing in a Sectional will automatically be entered in the National Championship at no additional charge.

The Roslyn Rifle and Revolver Club will conduct this N.R.A. International Sectional Match at their Indoor Range located at 1130 Broadway, Westbury, New York 11590.

RULES: Current NRA International Pistol Rules will govern.

SCORE CARDS: Sectional score cards will be used and must be signed by the competitor to be considered for national ranking and awards.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA international classification system will be used in all matches. Unclassified shooters will fire in the Master class. International Classification cards and Temporary Score books will be checked. Assigned classifications may be used (NRA Rule 19.6). Teams will be classified according to (Rule 19.12).

SCORING will be done by match personal.

PISTOL: Standard Pistol—Rule 3.5, Free Pistol—Rule 3.6. Air Pistol—Rule 3.7

TARGETS: NRA 50 foot targets Free Pistol B-11, Standard Pistol B-33, 33 feet (10meter) Air Pistol B- 40/1 or B-40/4 International Targets.

CHALLENGES: A Challenge fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each challenge made, to be refunded if upheld (Rule 16.1).

EYE and EAR PROTECTION are MANDATORY.

TIES: Will be broken according to NRA International Pistol Rules (Rule 15).

TEAMS: A team will consist of three (3) members representing an NRA affiliated club (Rule 2.11), a Regular Service unit, National Guard or Reserves (2.13). No Pick-Teams teams will be allowed.

CATEGORIES: Awards will be presented to HIGH GRAND SENIOR, HIGH SENIOR, HIGH WOMAN and HIGH JUNOR in the National Individual Championship only.

TEAM ENTRIES: Team members must be designated before the individual matches start. The individual match scores will be used for the team scores total. The team match is not a fired match. The total team fee must be paid prior to shooting the match.

ENTRIES LIMITED: Entries are limited to 10 competitors per relay.

POST ENTRIES: Post entries will be accepted up to range capacity provided additional relays are not required.

POST ENTRIES: Additional 5.00 will be charged per match.

MATCH SCHEDULE:

MATCH 1: Sectional Free Pistol Individual Championship.

60 shots standing, slow fire on the B-11 target. Total time will be 2 hours for 60 record shots. Record targets will be shot consecutively and fired in order. Unlimited sighters may be taken before the match (Rule 7.4).

MATCH 2: Sectional Standard Pistol Individual Championship.

60 shots standing on the B-33 target.

Slow Fire Stage: 20 shots in 4 series of 5 shots each; 150 seconds per series.

Timed Fire Stage: 20 shots in 4 series of 5 shots each; 20 seconds per 5 shot series.

Rapid Fire Stage: 20 shots in 4 series of 5 shots each; 10 seconds per 5 shot series.

MATCH 3: Sectional Air Pistol Individual Championship.

60 shots standing, time limit 75 minutes (1 hr., 15 min). On the B-40/1 or the B40/4 target. Unlimited sighters before record shots are fired, within the time limit.

AWARDS: If there fewer than 5 entries in a class, they will be combined with the next higher class. If there are fewer than 5 entries in the master class they will compete for open awards only. An individual or team winning an Open Award will not be entitled to a Class Award in the same match, such awards will be passed down.

The NRA will provide a souvenir pin.
